A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS TO ENTER AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS AND ENTREPRENEURIAL TECHNOLOGY OF RIZAL TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE LATTER'S EXTENSION SERVICES ON BASIC BOOKKEEPING AND BASICS ON VAT COMPUTATION

WHEREAS, the College of Business and Entrepreneurial Technology of Rizal Technological University (RTU-CBET) is one of the colleges of the renowned state universities of the Philippines that is based in Mandaluyong City and delivers quality and affordable education to the youth and professionals, through its instruction, research and extension services;

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2017, the City Government of Mandaluyong, through MS. MERLITA DG. TAMPINCO, Officer-in-Charge, Mandaluyong Manpower Technical and Vocational Training Center (MMTVTC) received a letter inviting the City Government of Mandaluyong through its various departments, sections and offices such as the MMTVTC, Negosyo Center and HRMD, to become Partner Agencies for their extension services;

WHEREAS, RTU-CBET's extension services will involve series of lecture-workshop on basic bookkeeping and basics on VAT computation, and it will be extended to the City Government of Mandaluyong as Partner Agency, free of charge, though assistance is sought as to added logistics and duplication of materials;

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the entrepreneurial programs of the City Government of Mandaluyong, the extension services offered by RTU-CBET for free will greatly benefit the employees of the City to enhance their bookkeeping skills and knowledge on VAT computation that they can apply in their service to the public;


WHEREAS, relative thereto, the City Legal Department reviewed the draft Memorandum of Agreement that defines the complementary obligations of the parties, and the same has been found to be reasonably and properly crafted and in accordance with law.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, to authorize the Honorable Mayor CARMELITA A. ABALOS to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the College of Business and Entrepreneurial Technology of Rizal Technological University for the conduct of the latter's extension services on basic bookkeeping and basics on VAT computation to the various departments, sections and offices of the City Government of Mandaluyong.
